Guidelines for Exhibits and Posters:

Table space and electric points will be provided as per requirement.

Each team can have a maximum of TWO participants per exhibit.

An abstract should be submitted for every exhibit / poster. The abstract should include the name of the college, names of participants, title, objective / aim, scientific principle involved, material used, working investigation findings, approximate cost, utility and further scope of the project.

The abstract should be sent via email to the following address: ruparel.sci.asso@gmail.com on or before 19th November 2011.

Guidelines for participants

- There is no entry fee.
- Students from undergraduate and postgraduate classes are eligible to participate.
- Every team should report to the venue 2 hours in advance and occupy the space and check the facilities required for the display of the exhibit / poster.
- The model should be arranged and set in all respects 9.30 a.m.
- The title of the exhibit / poster should be displayed properly.
- The exhibit / poster will be evaluated by a team of experts. At least one member of the team should be present at the exhibit / poster for providing explanation to the visitors. The participants should be well prepared for proper explanation and presentation.
- The parameters of evaluation include originality, scientific principles, technical skill, economic viability and presentation.
- The organizing committee's decision about the selected exhibits / posters will be communicated via email between 21st and 26th November 2011.
- Registration form should reach the organisers by 3rd December 2011.
- All participants should carry their valid identity cards.
- The decision of judges will be final and binding.
